

Reversing VS. Circling

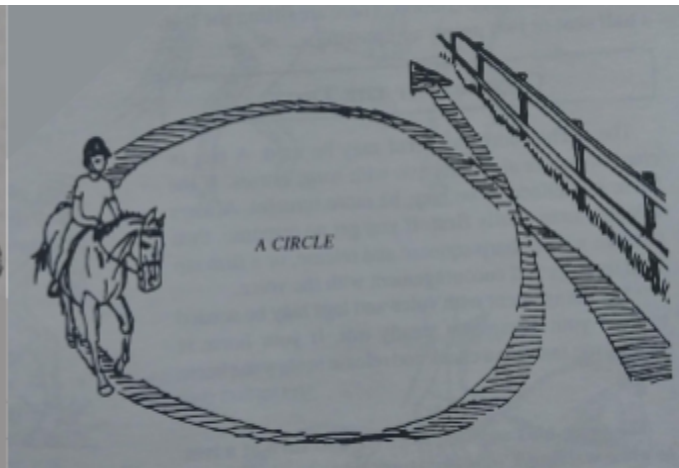
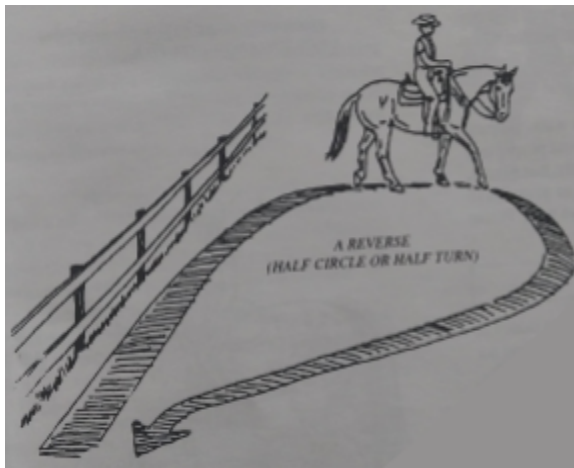
Reversing and circling are two different things. Here are some of the differences between the two.

Reversing

- Only ride half of a circle then go back on the rail.
- Look back at the wall and down the rail so the horse knows where to go.
- Change the direction that you are going.

Circling

- Ride a full circle all the way around.
- Look at the center so the horse knows to continue turning.
- Continue the same direction the whole time.



Even though these are two different things there are some similarities.

Both

- Squeeze your legs against the horse to keep them moving.
- Call out where you are going to communicate with others.
- Make a big round turn so you do not hurt the horse.
- Use your inside rein and outside leg to ask your horse to turn.
